Re: Homeowner Oil to Gas Conversions

Dear Bellerose Village homeowner

Recently there have been several situations where homeowners have be evicted from their homes because oil delivery people accidently pumped fuel oil into basements where the piping to the oil storage tank had not be plugged or removed during a gas conversion of their heating systems
It is now a state law that piping to a oil storage tank must be completely plugged or removed whenever a homeowner converts to natural gas as their heating fuel. The village prefers that the piping be completely removed. If yours was not completely plugged or removed,or if you are not sure, please contact the plumber who installed your gas burner and/or the village building inspector who will make doubly sure that this was done and that no potential hazard exists.
