

RFB Bellerose Village

Hudson Road between Commonwealth Blvd. and Pennsylvania Blvd.

Overview: The project calls for the renewal of road surface and the addition of 6" X 6" treated timber curbing to one block of Hudson Road in the Incorporated Village of Bellerose. The western boundary of this project is the intersection of Hudson Road with Commonwealth Boulevard and the eastern boundary is Pennsylvania Blvd. Prior to bidding, contractor will calculate the square footage of the proposed road work, perform grade measurements, and study current road surface after a rain for drainage and runoff issues. Any anticipated issues with grading, driveway aprons, curbing, trees, and roots should also be described in detail. If needed, contractor will arrange for mark-outs. Relevant findings will be clearly and fully described in the notes to proposal submission.

It is possible that the contractor plans to employ sub-contractors for the curbing, but the contractor shall include those services and assume responsibility for their satisfactory completion.

Workmanship and materials shall be warranted for a period of three years, not to include outright damage.

Paving: After installing curbing, existing road surface is to be milled to a depth of 1 ½" or to the substrate, whichever is greater. All milled materials will be removed and disposed of by contractor.

Contractor will purchase, pick up, transport, deliver, and install a minimum of 1 ½" of Nassau County specification hot asphalt and sealant ("tootsie rolls") to pave and seal the subject area. Contractor will warrant the work and materials for three years from the date of final invoicing. Bellerose Village will direct and control traffic and parking as needed to facilitate the work.

Curbing: Not all homes' frontage will require curbing but for those that do, curbing composed of 6" X 6" treated timber in 8' lengths shall be used with ½" x 24" re-bar stakes spaced not less than 5' apart; butt joints are acceptable. End pieces shall be mitered at 60 degrees.
